Definition of a Dangerous Dog

A dog that without provocation, has caused injury, other than killing or serious injury, to any person; or has killed another dog; or has been the subject of a third or subsequent violation of a prohibition regarding general confinement and control of dogs.

The following must be attached to this registration certificate

- Evidence of the dog's current rabies vaccination.
- Evidence of the fact the dog has been spayed or neutered.
- Evidence that the dog has an active microchip and the microchip number.
- Evidence of the fact that you have posted clearly visible "Dangerous Dog" warning signs.
- Evidence of liability insurance- if ordered by the courts

Additional Information

You are required by Ohio Law to:

Affix this tag to the dog's collar and ensure the dog wears the collar at all times.

Notify the Dog Warden *immediately* if the dog is loose, bites someone, or attacks another animal.

Notify the Auditor within 10 days of the sale, transfer of ownership, change of address, or death of this dog.

Renew your regular dog tag between December 1st and January 31st each year. After January 31st penalty will be applied.

Renew this dangerous dog registration each year. This registration expires 1 year from the date of issuance.

Notify the Auditor in former county and new county within 10 days that you have moved, providing new address to both counties.

I certify that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, the information on this form, under penalty of perjury, is true, correct, complete, and made in good faith. I understand that this form or the information it contains may be made available to federal, state, and/or local law enforcement agencies for such action within their Jurisdiction as they deem appropriate. I understand that knowingly making any false or fraudulent statement or representation to the government may violate federal, state, or local criminal statutes, and may result in a fine, imprisonment, or both.

2018 Dangerous Dog Registration

Please read and initial each statement.

_____ I am stating that I am 18 years of age or older as required by law to register a Dangerous Dog.

_____ The law prohibits a person who has been convicted of or pleads guilty to a felony "offense of violence" or felony offenses relating to domestic animals, weapons control, corrupt activity, conspiracy (attempt and complicity) and drug offenses committed on or after May 21, 2012 from knowingly owning, possessing, having custody of, or residing in a residence with a dog that has been determined to be a dangerous dog for a specified 3 year period.

_____ The law requires the County Auditor to collect specific information and documents from the owner of a dangerous dog before issuing the registration certificate and tag. The list of documents required is on the reverse side of this form.

_____ The law requires the owner of a dangerous dog to present the registration certificate upon request by any law enforcement officer, dog warden, or public health official charged with enforcing ORC 955.22.

_____ There are special confinement and control requirements for dangerous dogs. Please contact the Clark County Dog Warden at 937-521-2140 for details.

_____ It is illegal to debark or surgically silence a dog that the person knows or has reason to believe is a dangerous dog.

_____ The owner of a dangerous dog must continually post clearly visible signs at the residence warning both minors and adults of the presence of a dangerous dog on the property.

_____ If you transfer the ownership of the dog, you must notify the Auditor within 10 days and record a transfer of ownership certificate.

_____ If you or the dog relocates to a different address, you must notify the Clark County Auditor within 10 days. If you relocate to a different county, you must notify BOTH Auditors within 10 days.

_____ Making a false statement for the purpose of obtaining a government permit is a violation of ORC 2921.13(A)(5). A violation of this is a misdemeanor of the first degree.
